Applicants to the [**Online Master of Jurisprudence in Labor and Employment Law**](#) (MJ-LEL) are required to submit the following materials and meet the following requirements before the designated application deadline:

- Completed **online application form**
- Bachelor's degree** from a regionally accredited institution
- Official transcripts** of undergraduate degree(s), any other degrees and any university-level courses completed, even if a degree was not earned. Official transcripts and all supporting documents should be submitted to:

- Personal statement**
- Resume/CV**
- One letter of recommendation** from someone who is not related to the applicant

International Applicants:

- All applicants whose first language is not English must take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), achieving a **minimum overall TOEFL score of 90**, and demonstrate proficiency in English by completing **one year of full-time study with a minimum GPA of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale)** at a regionally accredited college or university in the U.S.
